

## **Staff Veterinarian (400516779)**

Duke University Medical Center (DUMC) has an immediate opening for a Staff Veterinarian, in the Division of Laboratory Animal Resources (DLAR). The DUMC animal care program is AAALAC accredited and supports a biomedical research community that in the category of NIH funding consistently ranks in the top five. The operation of DLAR includes over 200,000 sq. ft. of animal space with a daily census that spans a large variety of species, the opportunity to interact with and support a broad spectrum of research and training programs including the medical school, graduate programs, and biomedical.

The successful candidate for this position will join a team of 7 other veterinarians, and will be responsible for providing daily veterinary care for the rodent species housed in both barrier and conventional facilities and a wide variety of other laboratory animal species; further developing the veterinary care program through preparation and implementation of relevant operating procedures and policies; consulting with and training research personnel in handling, technical skills, and surgery.

Applicants must hold a Doctorate degree in veterinary medicine and be licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the United States. Federal accreditation (APHIS) is preferred. Excellent written, oral, and interpersonal communication skills are required. Candidates must be highly motivated, and well organized.

Evidence of clinical and surgical experience with a variety of laboratory animal species including rodents and board eligibility is desired. Experience and knowledge of academically oriented animal care programs, relevant federal and state regulations, the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee, and training others in the care and use of research animals is also preferred.
